PETER'S PENCE ANNUAL COLLECTION

Each year throughout the entire Church, on the Sunday nearest the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, a collection is held for the charitable work of the Pope, better known as Peter's Pence Collection. Pope Francis has shown us by his word and by his example the special concern he has for the poor and those on the periphery of society. Peter's Pence is one of the oldest collection in the Church - first mentioned in history as far back as 1031 and in Ireland it dates back to Norman times.

The Collection will be taken up at all Masses next weekend [Sat 30 July/ Sun 01 July] and will replace the normal SHARE Collection.
