Social Justice: An Invitation to Dialogue

The diocesan *Building Hope* initiative uses the Framework for Pastoral Renewal developed by the *Building Hope* Task Force to shape pastoral strategy in the Archdiocese. Over the last nine months the Servant Leadership quadrant, highlighting the co-responsibility of clergy and laity, has been the focus. As well as continuing this work, the *Building Hope* Pastoral Strategy Implementation Group is now providing resources to assist parishes and partnerships of parishes reflect on the theme of Social Justice – the social outreach of the parish, the tradition of communities of faith caring for those in need within the community and beyond.

‘SOCIAL JUSTICE: AN INVITATION TO DIALOGUE’ invites you to begin a conversation in your parish/partnership about Social Justice with an awareness of our mission as people of God to further justice in the world. It guides towards reflection on what social justice activities are sponsored by the parish or associated with the parish community and wider community, reflecting on questions such as: Who are we as a parish community? Has our community changed? What social justice groups are active? How can we raise awareness of social justice, work for peace, engage with environmental questions? What do we feel called to, now, in response to the social implications of the Gospel? You will notice too that the Pastoral Aid guides towards in a synodal approach with prayerful reflection, an emphasis on listening, on hearing the variety of voices present, in keeping with the synodal pathway on which the universal Church is travelling.

As part of the Social Justice focus, a conference organised by the Archdiocese together with the **LAUDATO SI’ COMMITTEE OF THE BISHOPS’ CONFERENCE** will take place on **FRIDAY 24 NOVEMBER** at the **BLANCHARDSTOWN CROWN PLAZA HOTEL**. An invitation has been extended separately to each parish, inviting a priest or member of the Parish Pastoral Council to attend. The theme is: **‘Parishes Caring for Creation’** and the Archbishop will be one of the speakers. We look forward to your parish being represented at the conference.

It is important that you begin your Social Justice conversation locally now in these months before Christmas and join in reflection on this theme across the diocese.
